Page 67, Chapter 4, Section 2.1, Medicare Part B prescription drugs	20% coinsurance for Part B drugs.	Due to the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), the cost-sharing for certain Medicare Part B prescription drugs may be subject to a lower coinsurance than 20%.	Effective April 1, 2023, you may pay a lower coinsurance for some Part B drugs.
